Boise GreenBike adds additional parking locations at Boise State University

The Boise GreenBike system recently added five new *Flex Hub* bike parking locations on the campus of Boise State University. These new hubs allow GreenBike users to lock up the bikes without paying the \$2 out-of-hub fee. The new locations are:

- On the southeast corner of the Micron Business and Economics Building, across the street from the Brady Street Parking Garage
- In front of the Morrison Center
- On Bronco Lane in front of the Kinesiology Building
- To the south of the Environmental Research Building
- On the northwest corner of Albertsons Library near the Friendship Bridge

Previously, there were only two station hub locations where the bikes could be returned without an additional fee: in front of the Student Union Building, and at the Interactive Learning Center. The new locations use existing bicycle racks that are identified as *Flex Hub* locations with Boise GreenBike stickers and sign panels. A *Flex Hub* can be used for both regular bikes and Boise GreenBike.

“We see great potential for bike share at Boise State,” said Dave Fotsch, Director of Boise GreenBike. “The challenge has been creating a broader network where the bikes can be locked up with the ‘out of hub’ fees. If this experiment is successful, we will explore adding even more *Flex Hubs* for Boise GreenBikes.”

Boise GreenBike offers Boise State students a \$46 annual membership, which comes with an hour of free ride time each day. That’s a 33 percent discount off the regular price of \$70. Students can also take advantage of a \$25 semester membership, which also includes an hour of free ride time every day.

About Boise GreenBike

Boise GreenBike is a novel transportation mode that provides another option for getting around the downtown area without getting into a vehicle. The system consists of 114 bikes at 15 stations. Most of the stations are located downtown; two are located at Boise State University. The bikes are available 24 hours a day.
