## **Ride Boise GreenBike to the Basque Soccer Friendly match Saturday (July 18)**

With the cost of parking ranging from \$10 to \$75 for Saturday's Basque Soccer Friendly match, Boise GreenBike is offering a low-cost, healthy and fun alternative - ride any of the Boise GreenBikes from downtown to Albertsons Stadium and park for free!

Boise GreenBike is working with Boise State Parking and Transportation Services to offer bicycle parking near the Christ Chapel, located on Broadway and Campus Drive, just south of the Broadway Bridge.

"Pick up a GreenBike at any downtown location," said Dave Fotsch, Director of Boise GreenBike. "Take a leisurely ride along the Greenbelt to the stadium and avoid all the hassles and expense of parking."

Fotsch further explained the flexibility of the GreenBike system in that he can draw temporary 'geo-fence' boundaries around a parking area for events like the soccer match. That means riders avoid the "locking out of hub" fees usually charged for locking up bikes away from one of the station hubs.

The bike corral, which is open to all bicyclists, will be staffed from 3-10:30 p.m. The soccer game begins at 7 p.m.

Boise GreenBike is a novel transportation mode that provides another option for getting around the downtown area without getting into a vehicle. The system is fully operational, with 114 bikes at 15 stations. Most of the stations are located downtown; two are located at Boise State University. The bikes are available 24 hours a day.
