**Main Street Station open house set for 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 13th**

**MERIDIAN – A public open house for the new Main Street Station in downtown Boise is scheduled for 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Thursday (Oct. 13).**

Open house attendees will be able to learn more about Main Street Station and how it will operate. There also will information available on ValleyRide bus system service changes scheduled to be implemented on Monday, Oct. 24<sup>th</sup>. The station is located at 777 W. Main Street, Ste. 170, below the Clearwater Analytics building.

Main Street Station will have eight bays for ValleyRide buses; additional bus space will be available on Main Street between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and the station’s exit ramp. The station will also have a customer service office, restrooms, a bike storage area that includes a repair station, and a Boise Police satellite office.

If you cannot attend the Oct. 13<sup>th</sup> open house, there will be two additional opportunities for the public to visit Main Street Station before it officially opens on Monday, Oct. 24<sup>th</sup>. These informal drop-in events are scheduled for:

- **11 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup>.** The informal drop in coincides with the City Center Plaza ribbon cutting event scheduled for 3:30 p.m. at the Grove Plaza. Main Street Station is part of the City Center Plaza project.
- **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup>.**
