My Activity Ride offers expanded free bus service in Nampa/Caldwell during summer break

CALDWELL – Looking for a cost-effective way to get you and/or your kids around Nampa and Caldwell during the school summer break? The My Activity Ride service provides expanded **free** transportation services on its two bus routes.

The routes, named the Purple Line (Caldwell Service) and the Blue Line (Nampa Service), operate Monday through Friday. The buses provide service to various stops within both cities and the Caldwell YMCA. Both routes connect directly to several ValleyRide bus routes.

School buses from Brown Bus Company and Caldwell Transportation Company provide the service. The buses can be identified by the orange GoRide decals. Each bus normally makes one afternoon trip a day when school is in session (except on holidays). During the summer, each route makes three trips a day – in the early morning, noon, and late afternoon. Both routes will return to the one-trip-a day schedule in late August. There are no age restrictions to ride the bus.

GoRide Community Link is a mobility project managed by Valley Regional Transit. The service is the result of a partnership between Valley Regional Transit, Brown Bus Company in Nampa, Caldwell Transportation Company, and the Caldwell YMCA.
