Next week's open house for Main Street Station rescheduled for Oct. 13th

MERIDIAN – A planned Sept. 21st open house for the new Main Street Station in downtown Boise has been **rescheduled** for **Thursday, October 13th**.

The Oct. 13th open house will be held from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. The station is located at 777 W. Main Street, below the Clearwater Analytics building. A dedication ceremony for the station's artwork will be held at noon that same day.

The public will also be able to drop by and take a peek at Main Street Station from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. October 20-21. The station's opening and the implementation of ValleyRide bus service changes will occur on Monday, October 24th.

Open house attendees will be able to learn more about Main Street Station and how it will operate. There also will information available on scheduled ValleyRide bus system service changes and existing and planned community-based transportation projects.

Main Street Station will have eight bus bays; additional bus space will be available on Main Street between 9th Street and the station's exit ramp. The station will also have a customer service office, restrooms, a bike storage area that includes a repair station, and a police substation.
